NOTICE OF INTENT TO REVISE FUEL SURCHARGE

Cathay Pacific Airways has filed with the Canadian Government to revise the current fuel surcharge effective **01 January 2018** for travel on/after **01 January 2018**.

If approved, the fuel surcharge will be applicable to new CX tickets and reissued tickets due to voluntary change of the first flight segment. The applicable surcharges are:

LONG-HAUL SECTORS:

- **From CAD62 to CAD73.50** between **North America, South West Pacific, Europe, Middle East, Africa & South Asian Sub Continent** and **Hong Kong**.

SHORT-HAUL SECTORS:

- **From CAD13.90 to CAD16.40** for **CX / KA sectors not mentioned above**.

All passengers, including children, infants and other discounted tickets are subject to the fuel surcharge. The fuel surcharge **will not** apply on:

1. CX/KA flights that commence in Hong Kong.
2. Any ground transportation services (connecting or code share)

The fuel surcharge applies to all fare types including Frequent Flyer Redemption.

The fuel surcharge will be collected at point of sale or ticket issue/reissue and be shown as "YR" in the Tax/Fees/Charges box of ticket.

This fuel surcharge is subject to Canadian Government approval. When this application has been approved, your CRS will be immediately updated.
